After a hiatus of several years, due to budget cuts, **Sculpturescape** is returning to the Colorado State University campus. Sculpturescape is an outdoor sculpture biennial at Colorado State University. Significant public works of sculpture from regional and national artists are placed on campus for the aesthetic and educational benefit of students, faculty, staff and guests of the University. This competitive sculpture exhibition, begun in 1998, is designed to demonstrate the value public art can have in our daily lives. The Sculpturescape program installs new artworks on campus every two years, adding to a sense of place, and thereby enriching and expanding the on-campus experience.

Public art has practical applications beyond the aesthetic and educational benefits it brings to the campus. It is an important part of Colorado State's master plan to make the university more pedestrian-oriented. Artwork provides landmarks and focal points in larger open spaces that improve way-finding and promote non-vehicular travel modes. Sculpturescape allows students, faculty, staff, and guests of the University to view changing artworks when they choose to walk or bicycle across the campus.

The first exhibition of work will be by sculptor **Bret Price** in Fall 2008. The Sculpturescape program is under the direction of **Professor Gary Voss** and funded through Facility Management at Colorado State. [Read more](#)

#### ONE PERCENT FOR ART AT COLORADO STATE

On November 14, 2007 the Associated Students of Colorado State University (ASCSU) passed a resolution that "one percent of the budget for the construction of new buildings and additions on campus go to buying art works that can be placed in or around the building; and, only students, faculty, and immediate community members can submit their art." The first recipient of this act will be a new academic classroom building to be built south of the Clark Building and scheduled to begin construction this summer.
